<p>Support with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Assessment - Care and support planning - Review - Safeguarding <p>Criteria: The person is living in and funded by Dudley.</p> <p>The person has a 'substantial difficulty' in being involved in the process meaning they would have problems understanding, retaining and weighing up relevant information.</p> <p>The person has no appropriate support – they may have no family or friends, or they may be inappropriate.</p>	<p>Support with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Serious medical treatment (SMT) - Do not attempt resuscitation (DNAR) - Safeguarding (alleged perpetrator of) - Accommodation move (after moving) <p>Criteria: The person is currently living in Dudley (including inpatients at hospital).</p> <p>The person lacks capacity around the decision/issue.</p> <p>The person has no appropriate support – they may have no family or friends, or they may be inappropriate.</p>	<p>Support with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Representing someone under a Deprivation of Liberty (paid RPR). - Or an application to the Court of Protection for DoLS in the community. <p>Criteria: The person is living in and funded by Dudley.</p> <p>The person lacks capacity around consent to their care.</p> <p>The person has no appropriate support to be a representative.</p> <p>The person is in a care home or hospital (DoLS).</p> <p>Or in a community setting (Community DoLS).</p>	<p>Support with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Various issues affecting people's lives such as care, accommodation and education - Support for people who do not fit the Care Act or IMCA criteria. - Support with home closures, safeguarding reviews and provider reviews <p>Criteria: The person is living in Dudley.</p> <p>The person has a learning disability.</p>	<p>Support with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Support during meetings, case conferences, LAC reviews, court hearings etc. - Helping empower the parent and make their voice heard - Liaising with solicitors and social workers <p>Criteria: The parent is living in Dudley and the local authority involved is Dudley.</p> <p>The parent has a learning disability.</p> <p>The child is involved with Children's services.</p>	<p>Support with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Various issues affecting people's lives such as housing issues, complaints - Issues outside the Parents Advocacy remit - Gathering information to aid informed choice - Writing letters, making phone calls, asking questions - Support at meetings - Ensuring the person's voice is heard <p>Criteria: The person is living in Dudley.</p> <p>The person has a learning disability.</p>
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
